We have received thousands of applications in less than 6 months. A significant number of our most promising applicants are currently unemployed and face significant financial challenges. They have asked for financial assistance to cover course fees, which they cannot afford independently. MEET TWO OF OUR PIONEERING FIRST CLASS

Mbali is a mother of two living in Soweto. She lost her job during the pandemic, and after many months of unemployment, she found a job as a cleaner at SPARK Schools. This pays her enough to live on but no more. Her dream is to become a teacher. Once employed, she would immediately double her salary and put her energy into supporting South African learners.

Kedibone is a single mother and our hardest-working student. At the start of the programme she didn't have a laptop; when she couldn't complete tasks on her phone she worked on paper, uploading photos for her lecturers. She has an Honours degree in Sociology, but could only find a job in retail where she works long hours for little money. She wants to provide the learners in her classroom with the skills to become effective leaders in South Africa.

What are we asking for?

These passionate young people need your help to gain the qualification needed to become a teacher. Student fees for our one-year programme are ZAR 45000, or roughly \$2400 / £1900.

Investing in the education of these aspiring educators is an investment in the future of South Africa, a country desperately in need of more, better-trained teachers.
